What is Student-Directed Teaching?

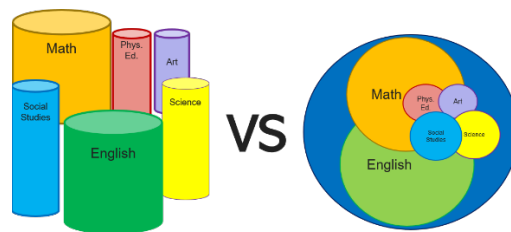
